WHAT IS SYFO?

Syfo Beverages are some of the purest, healthiest and most refreshing on the market today.

Syfo Beverages are Kosher Certified and contain:

- Purified Water by Reverse Osmosis
- All Natural Flavoring
- No Sugars or Artificial Sweeteners
- No Sodium
- No Preservatives or Phosphoric Acid
- No Fluoride
- No Caffeine
- No Calories

Purified water is water without impurities. Purity of water is measured by the TDS (total dissolved solids) count. This number tells us how many impurities are in the water (the lower the number the better).

If you look at the bottled water in your local supermarket, you will find an endless array of Spring Waters, Mineral Waters and Sparkling Waters. These particular kinds of waters can have a TDS count of between 90 and 950. These numbers may not seem high, however,

How Syfo Got Its Name

Syfo founder Charles Schussler started the business making and distributing seltzer water in syphons. Customers would ask for "syphos" of seltzer water, and the name that would become synonymous with quality was born.

when you break the TDS number down into its basic elements, you find things in the water that you really don't want and are potentially harmful—disinfection by-products, industrial and agricultural pollutants, pharmaceuticals and naturally occurring contaminants such as copper, lead, arsenic, radium, chromium, mercury—just to name a few. According to the Environmental Working Group (www.ewg.org), water utilities nationwide detected more than 300 pollutants between 2004 and 2009. More than half of these chemicals are unregulated and legal in any amount.



JUST HOW PURE IS SYFO?

- Water originating from the Upper Floridan aquifer is pumped into our production facility. The TDS count for that water is 180 PPM (parts-per-million).
- We run that water through a carbon filter and a double-micron filter. This filtration system removes the chlorine from the water.
- The next step is Reverse Osmosis, to eliminate metals, chemicals, bacteria, toxins and other solids.
- Then the water passes through a deionization system, which removes the ions of inorganic compounds such as iron, sodium and carbonates.



- Finally, the water is ozonated and exposed to UV (Ultraviolet) sterilization. This final step kills any organic material such as bacteria and viruses.

For the ultimate refreshment, carbonation and natural flavors are added to produce Syfo's Original Seltzers and Flavored Sparkling Waters.

The water's purity now measures between 6–10 parts-per-million total dissolved solids, making it one of the purest beverages in the world. At this point, the water has achieved a state of purity that allows it to be bottled as Syfo's 100% Purified Drinking Waters.

In an age where there is an increasing awareness of the health impact of what we eat and drink, Syfo Beverages are pure, healthy and refreshing alternatives to sodas and soft drinks and appeal to beverage lovers everywhere.

The all-natural flavoring in Syfo Sparkling Waters is derived from the oil selectively extracted from the peel of the fruit and is MSG and PG (propylene glycol) free.
